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Product Enhancements		
Module	Description	Benefit
Articles	<p><b>Front End Creation</b> A new add article button appears on the admin toolbar letting authors add articles from the front end, removing the need to go to the admin backend. This function currently caters for article title, description, Masterpage, template, url, start/expiry dates and folder location.</p> <p><b>Take Ownership</b> In the event that an Administrator needs to assist a user they can take ownership of a checked out article by clicking the <b>Locked</b> button on the admin toolbar. This function transfers checked out status to the administrator without checking the article back in.</p> <p><b>Code Insertion</b> Editors can insert article specific custom code (such as social media snippets) into the HTML head section of individual articles.</p> <p><b>Article Metadata</b> This has been extended to support sharing across multi-site configurations.</p> <p><b>Checked Out Warning</b> If a publisher navigates away from a checked out page, a warning will be displayed reminding the user to Undo Checkout or Publish the changes.</p> <p><b>Content Tag</b> The content “personalisation” tags interface has been improved to allow for fast searching, selection and insertion of tags.</p>	Improved publishing flexibility and usability for Authors creating a better overall user experience.
Campaign Monitor Integration	Form creator now has an integration option for the Campaign Monitor email marketing service. The form will pass the mapped firstname, lastname and email address to the selected Campaign Monitor list via a form creator submission.	Provides marketing teams with Integration to a best of breed email marketing service which means they can spend less effort on building campaigns and more time on the thing that really matters: developing engaging content.
Custom JavaScript	Added a function that lets front end developers create, upload and edit custom JavaScript files. These files are version controlled.	Provides developers with a simpler interface to create, edit or upload JavaScript.

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Dynamic Widgets	Dynamic Widgets now have an option to exclude the folder's default article. The default article is usually the article that contains the widget and does not need to appear in its own listing.	Provides authors with greater flexibility by allowing them to put dynamic widget content in the target folder.
Editors	<p><b>Editor switching</b> Added editor switching capability to toggle between Ephox, Telerik and the raw editor.</p> <p><b>Raw editor</b> Added a 'raw editor' which removes the potential for rich text editor string manipulation. This is relevant for users who are inserting HTML code from a third party tool and do not want the editor to "correct" their code.</p>	Improved editing flexibility so that authors can choose their preferred editing experience.
Form Creator	<p><b>Title Attribute</b> Form editors can set title attribute text for each form field providing real time tool tips as end users move between fields.</p> <p><b>Reordering Fields</b> Form fields can be moved and reordered by setting a sequence number for each field. This removes the need for multiple presses of the up/down button.</p> <p><b>Set Reply Address</b> A unique from address can be set for each form.</p> <p><b>Form Field Tags</b> Form creator confirmation articles can now contain specific field level tags allowing more flexibility in the design and content contained in form confirmation emails.</p> <p><b>CAPTCHA</b> The automated Turing test has been added in form creator to tell humans and computers apart.</p>	Improved form publishing options provide authors with a simpler interface for faster creation and editing of forms and the ability to tailor form responses. End users enjoy better tooltips and improved confirmation email options.
Login	Login buttons automatically change 'state' based on the status of the user. i.e. if <i>logged in</i> the button or hyperlink will change to "logout". If <i>logged out</i> the button or hyperlinks change to "login".	Provides site admins with additional flexibility for designing the login process and better usability for end users.
My Page	A new module has been released that provides every registered user with their own page at mypage/username. The first release of "My Page" allows users to invite friends and follow their friends to share	Enhances communication, collaboration, and

Nested Masterpages	Master pages now support nesting, with one master page referencing another as its master. Nested master pages allow the creation of more componentized master pages thereby reducing the number of master pages required to build a site and reducing the overhead when making adjustments.	Provides developers with a framework to build sites quickly and efficiently whilst reducing the maintenance overhead for site wide changes.
People Listing	<p><b>New Module</b></p> <p>This is a new article element which allows a user, with access, to generate and insert a list of users (firstname, lastname, email) in an article. The list can be generated based on criteria such as user group, business unit or department. Listings can display presence and optionally be hyperlinked to the user's corporate directory profile.</p>	Allows team leaders or department heads to insert corporate directory linked people listings of teams, departments or project groups enhancing collaboration and communication.
Security Permissions	<p><b>Folder Permissions</b></p> <p>Users with full access to a folder can set full, read/write and read only folder permissions from within folder attributes, removing the need for a round trip to the permissions page for minor changes.</p> <p><b>Folder Sharing</b></p> <p>The multi-site folder sharing function has been added to the permissions page as a function that can be set as no access, read only, read write or full access.</p> <p><b>Element Permissions</b></p> <p>Site Admins can set granular content element permissions (such as content editors, polls and forms) to allow or disallow insertion of specific elements.</p> <p><b>My Account Permissions</b></p> <p>Site Admins can set granular My Account permissions to allow or</p>	Gives site admins greater control and additional flexibility with respect to security options making it easier to set the permissions for a wider range of internal and external access options.

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	<p>disallow access to specific My Account options.</p> <p><b>Permissions Layout</b> The permission page layout has been adjusted to improve usability and accommodate the growing number of permission options.</p> <p><b>Permissions Toolbar</b> Site Admins with access to the corporate compliance module can now set granular toolbar button permissions for every button on the Telerik and Ephox toolbars to allow or disallow access to specific toolbar functions.</p>	
SEO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Changed the canonical URL to be fully editable, including domain name. This allows entry of cross-domain canonical tags.</li> <li>• Added the ability to set noindex, nofollow and noarchive robots meta tags to individual articles.</li> <li>• Added Robots.txt file access and editing for Site Admins.</li> </ul>	Provides flexibility for marketers and SEO professionals to optimise their site to increase traffic and conversions.
YouTube Integration	<p>Editors can reference YouTube rich media content and metadata in the document manager and then display this rich media content across the site using articles, search and dynamic widgets.</p>	Gives marketers the ability to easily use external repositories such as YouTube and removes the duplication often associated with managing internal and external content repositories.

Resolved Issues	
Module	Description
Article Check Out	Resolved the issue where articles were checked out to no one (a.k.a ghost checkout) and could not be checked back in. Isolated issue to article preview function.
Articles	Resolved issue where it was possible to drag an article into a folder containing an identically named article.
Blog	Removed "blog" folder reservation by renaming it to CMblog
Breadcrumb	Resolved issue with new breadcrumb control in TDCM which was not displaying foreign characters correctly.
Country Table	48 islands and territories added to existing country lookup table.
Document Manager	When modifying an existing document, the default setting prompted the user to upload a new document which was obstructive because in most cases only the metadata was changed. This has been modified to default to keep the existing version of the file on the server for existing documents.
Email Publishing	Resolved the following issues: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Documents submitted via email publishing had error incorrect in workflow due to incorrect folderID.</li> <li>Allowed duplicate URLs when publishing via email, now adding time/date stamp to URL to ensure uniqueness.</li> <li>Added support for multi-lingual content in email subject and body.</li> </ul>
eShop	Resolved the following issues: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Browser title was not using the eShop category name.</li> <li>Rollover images not working in eShop category page.</li> <li>Clicking on a small product image threw an error.</li> <li>Campaign code discount was not applied.</li> </ul>
Event Quick Search	Resolved issue with Next/Prev links in Event Quick Search not displaying events.
Events	Resolved issue where the mobile field on event registration did not allow spaces to be present in the number. The mobile field now allows spaces to be used.
FAQs / Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Links to FAQ items on search results pages are now configurable to allow admins to choose which view it goes to i.e. alpha or topic.</li> <li>When clicking on a link to an FAQ item from the search results page the user will be anchored to the alpha or topic area that the item resides in.</li> </ul>

Folder List Report	Fixed ordering of folders in List Folders report to match listing on Folder.aspx
Form Creator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Restored linked dropdown field functionality from Classic.</li> <li>Resolved issues where email routing and form reports were not working if special characters were present caused by overly protective script injection prevention.</li> </ul>
XML Site Map	<p>Resolved the following issues with the XML sitemap:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Updated scope to ensure the inclusion of all valid pages.</li> <li>Last modified date was using article creation instead of last edit date.</li> </ul>
LDAP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Offline Sync of LDAP now imports new users and disables users who were made non-active in LDAP.</li> <li>Modified the LDAP sync add-in to synchronise for a mapped group in case you don't want it to run over all groups.</li> </ul>
Link Management	Resolved issue with Link Management report showing incorrect data after upgrading from Classic to TDCM
Master Pages	Master page editor was not checking for duplicate id's. Now validates prior to saving.
Membership	<p>Resolved the following membership issues...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Member registrations for multi-sites were failing if the user had already registered on another multi-site.</li> <li>Redirection was not working due to an extra http:// in the link.</li> <li>If membership rules were set to activate immediately, it was not logging the user in and redirecting them to the correct article.</li> <li>Membership.aspx is now using Masterpages.</li> </ul>
Menu	<p>Resolved the following menu issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Menu setting 'display default article' was not copied with the operation that copies level 1 setting to other levels.</li> <li>Resolved issue where HTML menu ignored public folders following private folders</li> </ul>
My Account	<p>Added the ability for users to edit their own custom fields (where they are editable within the CMS and not integrated to AD/LDAP and marked as non-editable). These fields are currently specified via a nominated article and then displayed normally through the Corporate Directory interface.</p> <p>The labels used for each field depend on whether Corporate Directory is enabled: If enabled, then the labels from the "Fields to Display (User Fields)" section are used, otherwise field labels from the Form Creator module are used.</p>
Permissions	<p>Reinstated the following Classic functionality in TDCM:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Restrict page layout changes (i.e. element drag and drop).</li> <li>Restrict insertion of new elements.</li> </ul>

Print to PDF	The Print to PDF option has been updated to provide support for 64 bit environments.
Recycle Bin	If article of same name/url existed in recycle bin, the warning about the duplicate article did not indicate it was deleted.
Redirect links	Resolved a flaw in the logic that allowed redirects to work for sub-folders but not root folders.
RSS	Increased RSS feed URL length limit.
Telerik Editor	Resolved issue where the Telerik tag/property inspector was covering the publish button in Internet Explorer.
Training Manager	Resolved issue where auto removal of bookings which were cancelled, presented an opportunity for records to be corrupted if two people try to book the same user at the same time.
Undo checkout	Resolved issue when creating a new article and then selecting undo. The changes were not undone and error was thrown. System now gracefully handles the undo function.
Workflow	Resolved issue where author was not able to modify article if rejected by approver in workflow.

Feature	Reason
Remove pre and post customjavascript.js file references from System Stylesheets	Now that there is the new Custom JS section and pre and post customjavascript.js which can be edited, we have removed their references from System Stylesheets to avoid confusion or clashes in editing and saving the content.
Removed lockdown permissions	Removal of Classic features from TDCM which have been superseded by Masterpages and additional permission functionality in 7.5. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Restrict creating new template from existing article.</li> <li>• Restrict locking down editing of an article element.</li> </ul>
